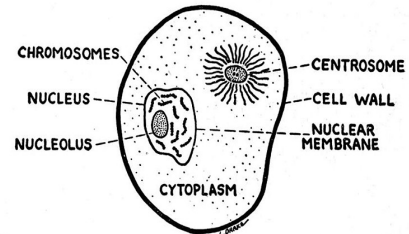

Concepts Taught:

- We are made up of trillions of cells.
- Each cell is like a mini-city.
- Cells come in all different shapes and sizes.
- Each cell has a special job (i.e. heart cells, blood cells, muscle cells etc.)
- A group of similar cells that perform a special job form tissue, such as skin, nerve, muscle, and bone tissue.
- Different tissues working together form organs, such as your heart and lungs.
- A group of different organs working together to perform a particular job form a system, such as the circulatory or respiratory system.
- All systems working together in a living being form an organism.
